





You have a new mobile device or you want to change your authentification method (MFA)? You have to set up your new method before you can delete the old method. Please proceed as follows:

- 1. In the Browser navigate to the website My Apps (microsoft.com).
- Click on your profile in the upper right corner and select **Account** (2).
- 3. In browser window on the left hand navigation bar, click the option **security information** (3).






- 4. You will see a dialog which shows the authentication method you are currently using. Please <u>do not</u> click on delete yet! First you have to set up your new authentication method.
- 5. Click New Method (4), to register your new mobile device or for another method.





- 6. In the drop-down menu please select the method of your choice (5). In this tutorial we will teach you the method with the **authenticator app**.
- 7. Finally select to **Add** this method (6).








- **8. Start by getting the app** (microsoft authenticator) on on your (new) mobile device. If so, please select **Next** (7).
- **9. Set up your account**, read the information on the dialog box before you click **Next** (8).


On the next page of this tutorial you will find dialog boxes appearing on your smartphone in the microsoft authenticator app during the setup (Step 9a and 9b). These steps are necessary before you can perform Step 10 of this tutorial!









- 9a) In the Microsoft authenticator app on your smartphone, click the plus sign in the upper right corner to **add a new account** (1).
- 9b) Choose **work or school account** (2), in order to scan the QR Code, which will be shown in the dialog box in the browser of your PC (step 10 of this tutorial).








10. In the dialog box of your browser (on your PC), you will be prompted to scan the displayed QR code 3). Please use your smartphone to scan this code with your Microsoft Authenticator App (not your native smartphone camera!). If you position the scanner frame correctly, the scan usually performs automatically (4). After the code has been scanned click **Next** in your browser dialog box (5).








11. Your Microsoft Authenticator App is now connected to your new authentication method. **Approve** the first push notification that appears on the mobile device (6). Once approved finish the process by clicking **Next** in the browser dialog box of your PC.

10. Your new authentication method has now been successfully set up, so that you can finally delete the old method. Open the website https://myapps.microsoft.com/, click on your profile in the upper right corner to select **Account** and choose **Security Information** in the following window (left navigation). Now, delete the old method by clicking **Delete** (see Screenshot).
